

Seething and Mundham Outcomes 2017

All our year groups are small compared to the national average, so each child is worth a high percentage. In a typical class of 30 pupils, each child represents 3% but our group of 12 year 6 pupils, each child is worth 8%. This higher value means that 1 child not achieving a result has greater effect on the outcome compared to the 1 child in a class of 30 not achieving the result.
