RE: Parent Questionnaire Feedback – Seething and Mundham Primary School

Dear Parents / Carers,

Thank you for taking the time to complete the questionnaire sent out to all parents and carers across the trust primary schools. We had 193 responses across the eight schools, which is over 70% of families responding. We were still receiving responses last week, and wanted to include everyone's views before responding.

From the information gathered, we are really pleased that there is a strong sense of support for our schools with 95% saying their children enjoy school. There were very strong responses to teaching and learning along with children's experiences.

The feedback indicates a desire from some parents for more information about the progress their child is making and about the school and trust's plans for the future developments. We will carefully consider these points together with the individual comments that were made.

There was lots of positivity around Seething and Mundham as well as lots of specifics mentioned in the questionnaire comments as well as during a meeting at the school recently. The areas have been discussed with the new head teacher Mr Hunter and there will be a meeting on **Thursday 6th December** at 6pm. In this meeting we will be giving parents and carers the opportunity to share what is unique and special about Seething and Mundham that we want to build on, as well as areas that can be developed and improved.

As a result of the questionnaire, we propose to:

- Provide more regular updates through a termly Parent Newsletter from the trust;
- Offer drop-in meetings to speak to trust staff and discuss ideas;
- Signpost our new website to allow for more information to be known about ourselves as a trust www.se-trust.org ;
- Continue to work with school council representatives to ensure student voice is heard;
- Offer further opportunities across the schools with key events such as English and Maths Competitions / Music Concerts / Art Festivals / Sports Competitions
